In that bright home far away*

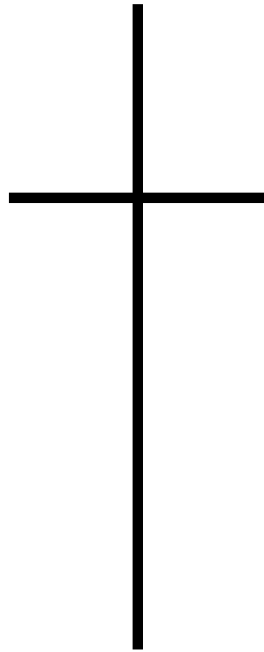
Friends I shall see who have journeyed before
